Notes	New and enhanced functionality

Enhancements and New Features

Ref #	Description
DFL9-01	When navigating between tabs and field screen, changes are not saved. This defect includes the popup window for "Field Additional Details". If you hit [CANCEL] in the dialog window, the changes are not saved back to the document model. You must click [SAVE] twice from the additional details screen to update the interface description in the database, and must use the main [SAVE] button to persist changes to the database. DBv9 now follows typical document editing model. Changes are buffered until the user presses [SAVE] (or F11) in the main setup window. DBv9 will attempt to warn you if you are about to exit without saving. If you move from an edited R/IF to another R/IF without saving, a prompt prior to loading the new R/IF will appear.
DFL9-10	Popup dialogs for create, copy, replace, and delete actions have been modified where the button mapping to positive action [ENTER] rather than [CANCEL] when user clicks their enter (return) key.
DFL9-35	Logging framework added for use with Functions. This is a technical tool to provide information regarding the use of the software product for troubleshooting purposes only. No employee data is recorded.
DFL9-43	Implemented the use a default MOLGA (SAP Country Code) to limit lookup values, allowing users to override / clear the default. Known to be an SAP issue, not all lookups limit themselves. When possible, the use a MOLGA to limit the search helps to improve the efficiency of generating the results. The MOLGA being used may be switched by pressing the "MOLGA = xx" button. The parameter ID "MOL" is read for the default (see transaction SU3).
DFL9-45	New Lookup tab in Record Details. "Lookup" functionality is intended to enhance the existing "Translate" functionality by granting access to most table data. Some technical knowledge is typically required to set this up. This is not designed for creating a "join", but to instead allow more flexible lookup. Access to PA and PD tables are restricted by standard SAP authorization checks. Additional authorization checks can be implemented by user exit.
DFL9-46a	MOLGA field now visible in the Record Details tab.
DFL9-46b	The test button will automatically save the current interface for testing purposes.
